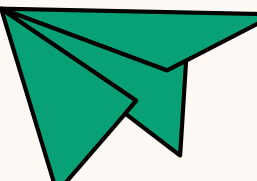


Passive voice

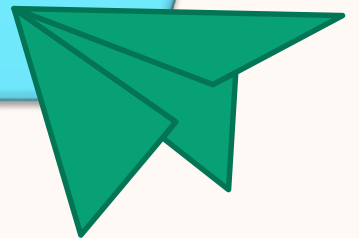
Active voice: The Vikings threw James into the water

Passive voice: James was thrown into the water by The Vikings



We form the passive by using the appropriate tense of the verb **to be + past** participle
e.g. The professor **was given** a sword

- Thieves broke into the house
- The house **was broken** into **by thieves**
- A cup of tea offered it
- It **was offered** a cup of tea

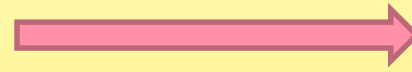
